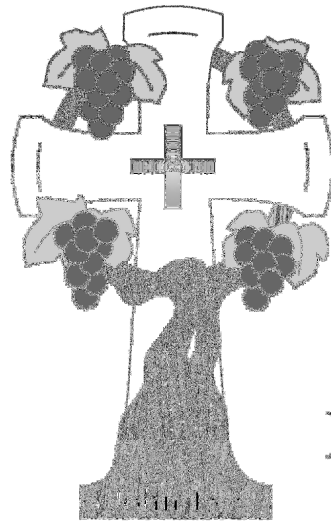

CLASS INFORMATION

Kindergarten
